

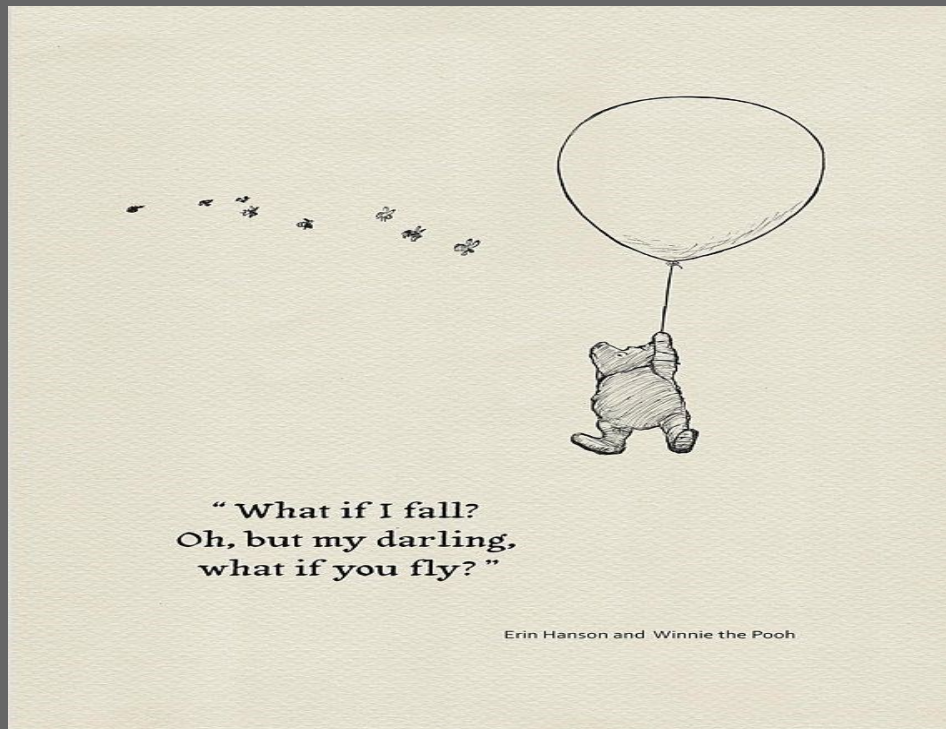

### **8th Grade High School Parent Meeting**

High School placement is a fun experience, however there are many things that have to be done in order to place your scholar in a high school. This meeting is the first step in that process. During the meeting you will be introduced to the following items and more:
