CELL PHONES/ELECTRONICS

Cell Phones may be brought to school, but must be turned off and put away in student's locker from 7:30am-3:30pm. If a student is seen with a cell phone during the day or the cell phone rings during the day, the cell phone will be confiscated and a parent may pick up the phone at the end of the day. If a student is caught using a phone in any manner during the day (talking, texting, playing games, listening to music, taking pictures, or use in any manner), the phone will be confiscated for a week.

Camp is an extension of school day - therefore no cell phones/electronics in camp or they will be taken away - same policy as during school day.

Wisconsin 3rd-8th grade students will be participating in the Forward Exam during March 19th-23rd and April 4th-20th. Scholars in 3rd, 5th, 6th, and 7th grades will be assessed in English Language Arts and Math. 4th and 8th grade scholars will be assessed English Language Arts, Math, Science, and Social Studies. It is very important that your son or daughter be in school during this time and well rested to take the exam.

3rd Quarter Parent Teacher Conference and Report cards

3rd Quarter Parent-Teacher Conferences are next week. These conferences are by request. Teachers will send home a conference form tomorrow which will indicate whether a conference is being requested. Please make sure to communicate with the teacher requesting the conference.

If the meeting is missed and no attempt to reschedule is made, the scholar will be held out of class until a conference is rescheduled.
