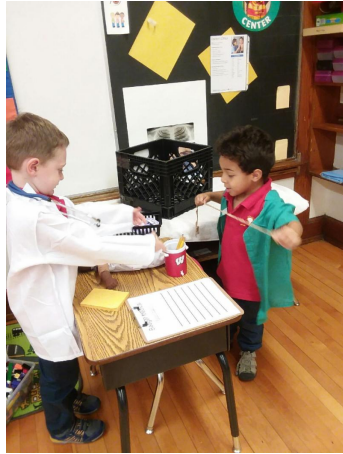

# CKLA (Core Knowledge Language Arts)



This year K4-1st grades are **committing** to learning through CKLA (Core Knowledge Language Arts). "With knowledge at the center, the possibilities are endless" - Amplify. CKLA sequences deep content knowledge with research based foundational skills. Results show that scholars have much greater gains as knowledge skills are built on prior learning, repeated exposure and horizontal and vertical lesson designs. While this looks very different than the MCP classrooms of the past, the learning and joy occurring in these classrooms are amazing! We are very excited to see the knowledge that is being built, the joy scholars are experiencing and the many moments of growth! There will be two informative CKLA Parent Meetings in October. If you are the parent/guardian of a K4-1st grade scholar, we recommend you attend one of the meetings to gain a more in-depth understanding of CKLA and how your scholar is learning.

## FORWARD ISR

### Wisconsin Forward Exam Information for Families 2018-19



#### What is the Wisconsin Forward Exam?

- The Wisconsin Forward Exam is designed to gauge how well students are doing in relation to the Wisconsin Academic Standards. These standards outline what students should know and be able to do in order to be college and career ready. The Forward Exam is administered online in the spring of each school year at: grades 3-8 in English language arts (ELA) and mathematics, grades 4 and 8 in science and, grades 4, 8, and 10 in social studies.
- Along with local measures such as report cards, school-wide assessments, and other information about your child's progress in school, the results from the Forward Exam provide insight into how well your child is doing on a broad

measure of achievement

- Students receive a score based on their performance in each content area.

Each score will fall in one of four levels:

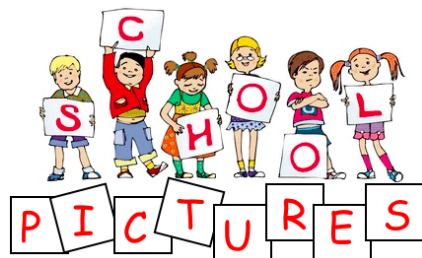
1. **Advanced** - Student demonstrates thorough understanding of and ability to apply the knowledge and skills for their grade level that are associated with college content-readiness.
2. **Proficient** - Student demonstrates adequate understanding of and ability to apply the knowledge and skills for their grade level that are associated with college content-readiness.
3. **Basic** - Student demonstrates partial understanding of and ability to apply the knowledge and skills for their grade level that are associated with college content readiness.
4. **Below Basic** - Student demonstrates minimal understanding of and ability to apply the knowledge and skills for their grade level that are associated with college content-readiness.

How do I receive my child's Forward Individual Student Report (ISR)?

- Forward ISR reports can be **picked up in the school office by parents or guardians**. Due to district policy, these reports may not be given to scholars or sent home with scholars.
