Visitors

Milwaukee College Prep always welcomes and encourages visitors, to our school. However, in order to assure the safety and well-being of all students and staff, all visitors - including parents and guardians - are required to sign-in with the receptionist in the main office to receive a green visitors pass. This pass should be displayed visably on your clothing.

If you are walking in the following procedure will now be followed:

- The main doors will be locked from **3:00 until 3:30**.
If you are picking up between 3:00 and 3:30 you will need to make arrangements with the main office **prior** to the end of the day.
- Beginning at 3:30 you can pick your child up from the back playground.
Each homeroom teacher will have a sign-out binder.
- We are not allowing scholars to leave because a parent sends a text message.

If you would like your child to meet you outside, they will need to be signed out as a walker or you will need to pick up from the back playground.

We understand that new procedures can take a longer time, however the safety of our scholars and our staff is our primary concern, therefore we are working to find the most effective way to approach school safety. If Milwaukee Public Schools closes due to bad weather, Milwaukee College Prep is closed. Listen to the radio or television for the announcement of the closing of MPS. Here is a reminder of MCP Athletic Event expectations. All scholars accompanied by an adult may attend the basketball game.
