- Have served no more than three terms in an AmeriCorps State or National Program

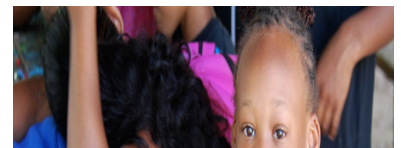
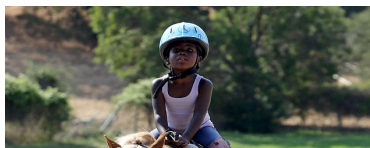
